BACKGROUND		
On December 5, 2001, Pacific Northwest Transportation Service, Inc., (Pacific) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective tariff, designated as thirteenth revised page 4.		
On December 28, 2001, the Commission entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions pending an investigation to determine whether the revisions are fair, just and reasonable.		
Staff has completed its review of Pacific's books and records and has determined that the rates and charges as filed are fair, just, and reasonable.
