
Dear Ms. Washburn:

As your files will reflect, the Orders Granting Temporary Exemption served in these matters on February 12, 2003 extended both American Disposal and Murrey's Disposal an exemption until January 31, 2005, to revise their billing procedures to comply with WAC 480-70-396. As previously indicated, neither company then had the billing software to accommodate the one month advance billing requirements in the revised rule. This is now to formally notify the Commission that the two companies will be in compliance with the maximum one-month advance billing requirement in WAC 480-70-396 with the next billing to be transmitted to customers in November, 2004.
