GA-79177 is an application for extension of certificate authority in Certificate No. G-11 to collect and transport solid waste from a portion of Pacific County.

As a result of the Commission's GIS mapping project, Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc., found that it had been providing solid waste collection services in a portion of Pacific County that is not authorized by its certificate.

The application appeared on the June 23, 2003, application docket. No one filed a protest, intervention, or application for overlapping authority during the docket and protest period.

This is an uncontested application for authority to provide service. There is no other existing certificate holder with authority to provide the service requested by Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc., in this docket. The applicant in this filing has no outstanding penalties, fines, administrative, or compliance actions pending before the commission. Staff has received no other information indicating this application should be set for hearing.

I recommend this application be granted without hearing and referred to staff for processing.

NOTES TO STAFF:

The applicant must file verified statements supporting the need for service in the requested territory.

The GIS staff has prepared text to revise and restate the authority in Certificate No. ~~G11~~ ^{G-11 MB}. GIS staff will also prepare a map of the revised certificate. The effective date of the maps should coincide with effective date of the order granting the extension.

The applicant will be providing service in the new territory at existing tariff rates. Tariff staff will need to confirm the status of the company's filed tariff and determine if any revisions are necessary.
