On June 6, 2003, application GA-79181 was filed by Blaine-Bay Refuse, Inc., under the provisions of chapter 81.77 RCW, for temporary authority to operate Certificate No. TCG-154.

The Commission having considered the application and being fully advised in the premises finds that it would be in the public interest to grant the application.

<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the application is hereby granted, that upon complying with the laws and rules relating to solid waste collection companies, a permit be issued to Blaine-Bay Refuse, Inc., of Ferndale, Washington, authorizing the carrier to provide solid waste collection service in that portion of Whatcom County described as:

- (1) All land between Drayton Harbor Road and Drayton Harbor
- (2) All land between Semiahmoo Drive and Drayton Harbor
- (3) All land between Semiahmoo Drive and Semiahmoo Bay
- (4) All land between Birch Point Road and Birch Bay
- (5) All land between Birch Bay Drive and Birch Bay
- (6) All land on Point Whitehorn between the land located north of Grandview Road extended west to the Strait of Georgia and shore land of Birch Bay

RESTRICTION: Limited to existing customers receiving service from Blaine-Bay Refuse, Inc., in the requested territory, on the effective date of the order granting this temporary certificate.

This temporary certificate will end automatically, by operation of law and without further Commission action, when (1) the Commission enters an order approving withdrawal of Application No. GA-79154, or (2) the Commission enters an order granting Application No. GA-79154. If the Commission denies, dismisses, or grants less than all of Application No. GA-79154, this temporary permit will

terminate on the last day for seeking judicial review of the Commission decision or, in the event of judicial review, on any later date that the reviewing court may order.
