Discussion

On June 24, 2004, Mark Doubravsky Trucking, Inc., and Doubravsky / Doubravsky, Inc. filed joint Application No. P-79287 to transfer Household Goods Carrier Permit No. HG-135 under the exceptions contained in WAC 480-15-260. The application appeared on the Commission's June 28, 2004, application docket subject to comment for 30 days. No comments were received.

Under the exceptions to the application process contained in WAC 480-15-260 the Commission will grant an application to transfer permanent authority (without public notice or temporary operations) when a shareholder in a corporation has died and that shareholder's interest is being transferred to a surviving spouse or one or more surviving shareholders.

In settling the estate of Edward Doubravsky, Doubravsky / Doubravsky, Inc., has reorganized resulting in a distribution of assets, including Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 135, to Mark and Kimberly Doubravsky.

Mark Doubravsky Trucking, Inc., is registered with the Department of Licensing, Master License Services. The company holds a valid UBI number with active tax, unemployment, and industrial insurance accounts.

Recommendation

P-79287 is an application for transfer of a decedent's interest and no hearing is required. There are no outstanding issues that suggest staff should ask the Commission to set the application for hearing.

I recommend that Licensing Services Staff prepare an order to grant Application No. P-79287 without hearing and reissue Permit No. HG-135 to Mark Doubravsky Trucking, Inc.
