On September 14, 2005, the Utilities and Transportation Commission approved Avista's request to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire within the certificated area in Spokane County. The location added in Spokane County was contiguous with and related to its present certificated area included in Appendix 1 of the Company's CPCN.

After recent discussions with Commission Staff as it relates to the Appendices to the Company's CPCN, the location approved for addition to Avista's CPCN in this docket was not reflected in Appendix 1.
