As you are aware, on January 17, 2006, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued a Penalty Assessment against Elite Charters, Inc. in the amount of \$21,700 for violations of a December 6, 2005, Order in Docket TE-050009, in which the commission canceled Elite's operating authority.

The commission has not received the \$21,700 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$21,700 balance.
