## Discussion:

On May 11, 2006, Donald Arroyo & Danise May Arroyo-Sykes, d/b/a Rainier Moving Systems, Inc., filed a joint application for authority to acquire control of Household Goods Permit No. HG-29516. Application No. P-79455 appeared on the commission's July 31, 2006, application docket subject to comment for 30 days. No comments were received.

Under the exceptions to the application process contained in WAC 480-15-260 the commission will grant an application to acquire control of permanent authority (without temporary operations) when control is being transferred to a shareholder familiar with the company's operations and the household goods moving services provided.

Donald Arroyo has managed Rainier Moving Systems, Inc. for 10 years and will continue to operate the daily business and maintain the safety and services currently offered.

Rainier Moving Systems, Inc., is registered with the Secretary of State as a corporation doing business in Washington State, has a valid UBI number with active tax, unemployment insurance, and industrial insurance accounts.

## Recommendation:

This is an uncontested application for acquisition of control of an existing household goods permit and, therefore, no hearing is required. There are no outstanding issues that suggest staff should ask the commission to set the application for hearing on its own motion.

I recommend that Licensing Staff prepare an order granting Application P-79455 allowing Donald Arroyo and Danise May Arroyo-Sykes to acquire control of Permit No. HG-29516 held by Rainier Moving Systems, Inc.
