Dear Ms. Washburn:

By this letter Qwest is requesting a waiver of the utilization threshold requirements outlined in FCC's Numbering Resource Optimization Orders, FCC 00-429 and FCC 01-362 released in CC Docket No 99-200, which would allow PA/NeuStar, the Number Pooling Administrator, to reserve and assign a thousands block from an NXX that ends in either a "2" or a "6" (NX2 or NX6), A Qwest customer is expanding their operations, and is in immediate need of 700 new numbers.

The request is for 1,000 sequential telephone numbers in the 360 NPA, Pt Angeles (Port Angeles) Rate Center. Our customer has specifically requested numbers that fit with their internal dialing plan. After receiving these numbers, the customer will not be returning any currently utilized numbers. Qwest will place the remaining three hundred numbers into our existing numbering pool for other customers to use. The original customer request has been provided with this letter as Confidential Attachment A.

In our effort to satisfy the customer's request, Qwest submitted a request to PA/NeuStar on February 12, 2007 for additional numbering resources. That application and the subsequent denial have been provided as Confidential Attachment B & C respectively. In order for the request to be approved, Qwest will require a waiver of the current usage threshold for new numbering requests.

The FCC allows for a waiver of the rules when there is demonstrated need such as a specific customer request for a large block of numbers. The waiver process is specifically addressed in the FCC Third Report and Order ("Order") as the "safety valve" process (See FCC 01-362, paras. 57-66), which went into effect on March 14, 2002. The Order delegates the authority to hear claims for waivers to the state commissioners and recommends that state commissions act expeditiously. The Order proposes that state commissions review a waiver within 10 business days. (See Paras. 61,66)


Qwest respectfully requests that the Commission approve the request for a waiver of months to exhaust threshold requirements, and direct PA/NeuStar to provide Qwest with a thousands block from either an NX2 or NX6 in the 360 NPA, Pt Angeles Rate Center.
