## Attachment 7 – Description of Pricing and Services for Frame Relay Service (FRS)

This Attachment 7 (Description of Pricing and Services for Frame Relay Service)(this <u>Product Schedule</u>) is entered into as of the date of last signature by a Party (the <u>Product Schedule Effective Date</u>) by and among GTE.NET LLC (d/b/a Verizon Internet Services) and Verizon Internet Services Inc., on its own behalf and on behalf of its affiliates identified in Attachment 1.1 of the Agreement (<u>Customer</u>) and Verizon Services Corp. on behalf of the Verizon operating telephone companies set forth on the signature page to this Product Schedule (individually and collectively, <u>Verizon</u>). This Product Schedule is attached to that certain Master Services Agreement (<u>Agreement</u>), dated as of February 6, 2007, by and among the Parties, and made a part thereof. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Product Schedule, the Product Guide, or in the Agreement shall have the meanings set forth in Verizon's Tariffs FCC Nos. 1 and 20 (individually, <u>Tariff</u>, and collectively, <u>Tariffs</u>), as applicable.

## 1. <u>Service Description</u>

- General Description: Verizon's Frame Relay Service (FRS or the Service) is a data communications service that provides for data connectivity (up to the DS3 level) between and among widely distributed End User locations. Verizon provides this connectivity via Permanent Virtual Connections (PVCs) to Verizon's switching platform. The data is divided into variable sized packets called frames and each frame is sent separately through the network. At their destination, these frames are reassembled. A full description of the Service is set forth in the Product Guide (defined below).
- Product Guide for the Service: To the extent not inconsistent with the provisions of this Product Schedule or the Agreement, the complete description of the Service and all terms and conditions for the Service are contained in the FRS Product Guide' (Product Guide FRSPG\_v1\_042707) which is incorporated herein by reference and has been provided separately to Customer. The Product Guide contains a comprehensive description of the Service for use by Customer, including without limitation for the following reasons: (i) in connection with its initial review and analysis of the Service; (ii) in making a decision as to whether or not to enter into negotiations for the Service to satisfy its particular business needs; (iii) in maintaining its Service in the most advantageous manner; and (iv) in staying abreast of enhancements or other modifications to the Service.
- 1.3 Changes to the Product Guide: Subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of this Product Schedule and the Agreement, Verizon in its sole discretion shall have the right to change terms set forth in the Product Guide. In accordance with Section 25 (Notices) of the Agreement, Verizon shall provide notice of any change to the Product Guide, and such changed Product Guide shall be the Product Guide as defined herein, and such changed Product Guide shall apply to all existing and new Services provided to Customer pursuant to the Agreement, the Product Guide and this Product Schedule from the date of such change to the Product Guide.
- 1.4 <u>Tariffed FRS and New Purchases of the Services</u>: The Parties hereby agree as follows:

- (a) New Purchases of Frame Relay Services: As of the Product Schedule Effective Date, Customer shall not place any new orders for the Service which are offered pursuant to the Tariffs (including such services offered pursuant to contract tariff options, individual case basis tariffs, specialized service arrangements, and all other tariffed arrangements) (collectively, Tariffed Service(s)). Customer shall place all new orders for the Service pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Product Schedule, the Product Guide and the Agreement.
- (b) Conversion of Existing Tariffed Service(s) to FRS Services: Subject to the following sentence, Customer may convert Tariffed Service(s) purchased prior to the Product Schedule Effective Date to FRS provided pursuant to the terms of this Product Schedule and the Agreement. Customer may convert its Tariffed Service(s) to FRS under this Agreement and subscribe to a new Commitment Period of equal or longer length than the Commitment Period for the Tariffed Service, on the terms and conditions, including the rates and charges, set forth in this Product Schedule and the Product Guide.
- (c) Orders in Progress: Subject to the ability to convert such Tariffed Service(s) to FRS hereunder in Section (b) preceding, any orders placed under the Tariffs prior to the Product Schedule Effective Date for Tariffed Service(s) shall continue to be governed by the terms of the Tariffs.

## 2. Terms and Conditions

In order for Customer to receive the rates, terms, and conditions for the Service as set forth in the Agreement, the Product Guide and this Product Schedule, Customer must place the contract number assigned to this Product Schedule in the designated field of all service orders (to include Access Service Requests (ASRs)) submitted in connection with the Service.
