1 On October 2, 2007, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Docket TV-071800 canceling Common Carrier Permit No. CC-62995, in the name of Pacific Coast Hauling Inc, for failure to file proof of liability and property damage insurance covering equipment.

2 It has now come to our attention that the insurance notice and order suspending/canceling Common Carrier Permit No. CC-62995 were incorrectly addressed and the carrier was not properly notified. The error has now been corrected and proof of liability and property damage insurance covering Common Carrier Permit No. CC-62995 is properly filed.

3 Upon consideration of the facts surrounding the cancellation, the Commission finds that the order of cancellation should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** That Docket TV-071800 dated October 2, 2007 insofar as it refers to cancellation of Common Carrier Permit No. CC-62995, in the name of Pacific Coast Hauling Inc, is rescinded.

5 The commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.
