### **Recommendation**

Take no action on this filing at this time to allow for customer comments.

### **Discussion**

On August 4, 2008, Crescent Bar, Inc. (Crescent Bar or company), filed with the Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) tariff revisions that would generate \$20,248 (26.4 percent) in additional revenue per year. The company serves 470 customers near Quincy in Grant County. These customers are in four condominium complexes and two recreational vehicle parks. The proposed rates are prompted by increases in power, insurance, and maintenance expenses.

Today's presentation allows customers or other parties to make comments to the commission. No action is required by the commission. Staff will make its recommendation to the commission at the open meeting on September 25, 2008. The company's last general rate increase became effective in June 2004.

On July 28, 2008, the company notified its customers of the rate increase by mail. The commission has received no customer comments on this filing as of September 8, 2008.
