As you are aware, on February 20, 2009, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued a Penalty Assessment against Pacific Transportation, Inc. in the amount of \$100 for failure to file the Company's 2008 Annual Safety Report, as required by commission rules.

The commission has not received the \$100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$100 balance.
