Dear Mr. Danner:

Please find attached copies of revisions for G-60 Tariff Number 27 for Fiorito Enterprises, Inc & Rabanco Companies (dba Kent-Meridian Disposal Company, Allied Waste of Kent). This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for residential customers in the Serivce Areas defined in Appendix A from a credit of \$0.54 to a credit of \$0.15 per month and for multi family customers, from a credit of \$0.05 to a credit of \$0.12 per yard. Enclosed are the accounting work papers.

The attached revenue sharing agreement certified by the county indicates a 50% retention rate for the company based on the new threshold approved via HB-2539.

Also included is King County's certification of an extension of current commodity rates approved via TG-090737 through July 31, 2010
