## 23. Relevant carrier history:

Comment:

No prior intrastate history. This carrier is making application for intrastate authority but has been operating interstate from Bismarck North Dakota for over two years and had received a full CR 3/11/2011 and had been issued a satisfactory safety rating. Per the company general Manager Jim Harlow, the comp[any is moving its main corporate office to Auburn Washington with only a terminal still operating in North Dakota. The CR review conducted by FMCSA in North Dakota is attached for review; The company has a 57.3% basic in the crash indicator category and only a 7.1% basic in vehicle maintenance. A copy of the company's SMS scores is attached.

## 24. Findings:

This carrier's vehicle is a new 2011 51 passenger Prevost and has yet to be used to transport passengers. No defects were found. The company has plans to add four or five additional motor coaches in the next few months and will notify UTC as each is brought into the fleet. The owner and safety manager was provided safety training by me in 49 CFR 382, 383, 387, 390, 391, 392, 393, 395 & 396.

This carrier also is a lease agency of school buses to private school in the local areas and provides drivers for these vehicle leases. Although this contract work qualifies under the school exemption rules by providing home to home service and is inspected by WSP, the company may also have some buses that only provide charter service to these schools. The company management now understanding what is regulated by UTC will be re-examinating its business policies and making sure the appropriate authority is achieved before providing any illegal operations.


