TO ALL PARTIES AND INTERESTED PERSONS:

On September 14, 2012, Seatac Shuttle, LLC d/b/a Whidbey-Seatac Shuttle (Seatac Shuttle) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition for a Declaratory Order (Petition) requesting the Commission resolve the definition of "New Service" as used in both transportation rule and code. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.240 and WAC 480-07-930, the Commission gives notice of Seatac Shuttle's Petition to all persons required by law and such other persons as deemed appropriate. The Commission also by this notice invites interested persons to submit a statement of fact and law on the issues raised by the Petition. Within thirty days of receiving the Petition, the Commission must either enter a declaratory order, notify Seatac Shuttle that no order will be entered, establish a date by which the Commission will enter an order, or set a date and time for a hearing.

**NOTICE IS GIVEN That the Commission requests that interested persons who desire to be heard in this docket present a statement of fact and law on the issues raised in the Petition, including the applicability of Washington statutes and Commission rules to those issues. All persons interested in this matter must submit either a statement of fact and law or a request to be placed upon the Commission's service list in the event of further proceedings. All comments must be filed with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, September 28, 2012.**
