RE: Interconnection Agreement between CenturyTel of Washington, Inc., CenturyTel of Inter Island, Inc., and CenturyTel of Cowiche, Inc., collectively d/b/a CenturyLink and Comcast Phone of Washington, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone, Docket No. UT-123025

Dear Mr. Cullari:

On November 15, 2012, CenturyTel of Washington, Inc., CenturyTel of Inter Island, Inc., and CenturyTel of Cowiche, Inc., collectively d/b/a CenturyLink and Comcast Phone of Washington, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone (Comcast), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a request for approval of an interconnection agreement (agreement). The agreement is a delegated item scheduled for approval by February 13, 2013.

WAC 480-07-640 requires interconnection agreements be submitted for approval within 30 days after they are signed. The last signature appearing on the agreement is dated October 24, 2011, the Commission should have received the agreement no later than November 23, 2011; therefore, the agreement was filed 358 days late. The Commission reserves the right to investigate and, if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize Comcast for failure to meet the filing requirements.
