RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment TE-130193

Dear Mr. Montgomery:

As you are aware, on March 4, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Curtis Express Shuttle, Inc. in the amount of \$900 for violation of WAC 480-30-071, which requires charter and excursion carriers to file annual safety reports and WAC 480-30-076, which requires such companies to pay regulatory fees with the Commission by December 31 each year. Curtis Express Shuttle, Inc. has failed to file its annual report for 2012 or pay its 2013 regulatory fee and has incurred a penalty of \$900. The Commission sent Curtis Express Shuttle, Inc. a Second Notice on April 11, 2013, and a Final Notice on May 15, 2013.

The Commission has not received the \$900 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$900 balance.
