Note 2: One adult round trip is \$98.00.

Note 3: Senior fares apply to passengers who are 65 years of age or older.

Note 3: On adult senior one way is \$56.00; round trip - \$93:00

Note 4: Children under 6 ride free. Children over 6 will ride at half fare.

Note 5: Animals are \$10.00 per animal when accompanied by owner, adult rate without owner.

Note 6: Holidays observed: Christmas, Thanksgiving, Independence Day, Passover.

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PASSENGER RULES

Adult fares: Published fares are adult fares and apply to passengers who have reached or passed their twelfth birthday.

Animals: Animals, birds or other pets will be transported if they are caged and present no harm to other passengers. Service animals will be allowed in the passenger area of the vehicle but must lie on the floor near the owner and not in the seats. No service animal will be allowed next to the driver but must be to the rear of the driver. Animals will be transported without the owner at the adult rate. A 10 dollar charge will apply if the owner accompanies the animal.

Baggage: Each paying passenger will be allowed 2 normal sized articles plus one carryon. Normal is defined as having a combined measurement of up to 70" and less than 70 pounds. Any passenger with more than that will be charged \$5.00. Carrier will not accept odorous or leaking bags. Carrier will not be liable for lost or misplaced personal belongings.

Baggage Liability: As provided by Washington state law (RCW 81.29.050), unless higher value is declared prior to transportation and agreed to in writing by Vashon Shuttle, property damage liability will be \$25.00 for boxes and parcels, \$200.00 for trunks and \$50.00 for suitcases, valises and other items. Additional valuation will be charged at \$1.00 per \$100 or fraction thereof.

Cancellations: Add – A customer who has made a reservation but fails to cancel, reschedule, or appear at the designated pick-up point by the schedule departure time is not eligible for a refund unless the failure was caused by an airline delay or cancellation.

Children Fares: Children under six years of age will ride free. The child must be in a secure seat and not in the lap of a parent. The company may not provide or assist with the seat. Children over six will ride at half fare.

Disclaimer and Wait Time: Pacific Northwest Distributing, LLC dba/ Soundairporter will not be liable for missed flights, delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of roads, snow storms or other conditions beyond the control of the carrier. The carrier will wait for 30 minutes maximum for any delayed flight.

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PASSENGER RULES (cont'd)

Holidays Observed: Christmas, Thanksgiving, Independence Day, Passover.

Objectionable Passengers: This company will not transport persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, persons who are incapable of caring for themselves, or whose conduct is objectionable to other passengers or present a risk to the safe operation of the vehicle and security of the driver and the passengers.

Round trip fares: Round trip fares will be computed at double the price of a one-way fare minus \$10.00. These fees apply to one passenger fare only.

Schedule Maintenance: The company will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, bad conditions of the roadway, snowstorms and other conditions beyond the control of the company and does not guarantee arrival or departure from any point at any time.

Senior Fares: Senior Fares apply to passengers who are 65 years of age and older.

Stop Overs: Stopovers will not be allowed.

Ticket limitations: Tickets will be good for 3 months from the date of sale.

Ticket redemption: Unused tickets presented by lawful owner will be redeemed for 90 days from the date of sale. Lost tickets will not be refunded.

Ticket Refunds: Unused tickets will be redeemed at the purchase price and unused portions of round-trip or commutation tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portion or portions used, and refunding the balance of the purchase price.

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
