- On April 8, 2014, West Isle Air, Inc., filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a passenger transportation company in the state of Washington under RCW 81.68.
  West Isle Air, Inc.'s application is incomplete as it lacks the ridership and revenue forecasts for the first twelve months of operation, a balance sheet and income statement, a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E), and a CVSA safety inspection of the vehicle.
- 2 On May 20, June 16, and July 7, 2014, the Commission sent correspondence to West Isle Air, Inc., to comply with the application requirements in RCW 81.68 and WAC 480-30. West Isle Air, Inc., has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- The application filed by West Isle Air, Inc., in Docket TC-140583 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.68 and WAC 480-15.

## **ORDER**

- 4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by West Isle Air, Inc., on April 8, 2014 in Docket TC-140583 for a passenger transportation certificate authority is dismissed.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(6)(h).

Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.
