As of 4 PM today all 911 services are down in Winthrop and Twisp, WA due to the expanding fires in the region. Please let people know to use ten digit phone #s [(509) plus the #] to contact local fire stations and police in case of an emergency when calling from those areas.

7/18 4:15PM UPDATE

Active fires have now caused the 911 services in Pateros, WA to go down as well. Again, please instruct people to use the 10 digit # to contact local police or fire stations in case of an emergency. We are working round the clock to keep our services intact but are also taking every precaution to keep our customers and employees safe.

PLEASE ADVISE VIEWERS, LISTENERS and READERS: All phone and internet services including 911, local and long distance are down in Twisp, Pateros, Mazama and Winthrop. Services are intact in Mallot, Omak, Okanogan, and Oroville, however, due to extensive fire damage in the surrounding areas, bandwidth is limited. Trunks are full and that is why you will hear a "fast busy" when you try to make a phone call. Calls are going through on a limited basis and we are asking all customers to please limit local and long distance calls to emergency use and 911 only. Please contact me if you have any questions.

Media Update: 7-21-14, 10: 45 AM

All 911, Local, Long Distance and internet is in working order in Omak, Okanogan, Oroville, Mallot, however trunks are extremely busy so people may be receiving "fast busy" connections. We ask customers for their patience as calls are getting through but it may take several re-dials, and to limit use as necessary to allow for emergency calls.

All 911, local and long distance phone as well as internet services remain down in Mazama, Pateros, Twisp and Winthrop due to extensive fire damage throughout the area. With destroyed fiber cables and equipment, we cannot provide an estimated time for restoration and anticipate services to be down for an extended period of time. Our crews continue to work around the clock to reestablish connectivity throughout the Methow Valley area.

If calling 911 or another number from a cell or other phone connection in Mazama, Pateros, Twisp or Winthrop please use 10 digit calling: (509) plus the 7 digit number.

Hello All –We are working 24/7 with our teams to restore services to all impacted areas in the Methow Valley and are happy to report that internet connections have been restored in Mazama, Pateros, Twisp and Winthrop WA. We will continue to work on 911, local and long distance phone services, however, due to the severity of the fires, we are having to completely rebuild some of our central office equipment and re-install miles of fiber cables which is taking time. Our crews do report that great progress was made in the last 24 hours.

In Okanogan, Omak, Oroville, Mallot, Republic and Tonasket, services are in working order but phone trunks are very busy and some may experience a "fast busy" when trying to make a call. We are asking all to be patient and remember to use (509) plus the 7 digit phone number when calling in these areas. Our internet connections are also working in these communities but are very congested due to burned fiber cables that have limited the bandwidth and heavy use.

As more information becomes available I will send another update. Thank you for informing your viewers, listeners and readers of our status.
