Evergreen Park Dr. SW, in Olympia. RCW 81.68.015 provides auto transportation companies' the opportunity to petition the Commission requesting forbearance from rate regulation. The Commission is accepting written comments regarding this proposal. **Written comments must be submitted to the Commission no later than May 27 by 5 p.m. or comments may be presented during the scheduled open public meeting.** Please identify the comments by the respective Docket No. TC-140156. Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc., d/b/a Capital Aeroporter Airport Shuttle (Pacific) (Cert. C-862) in Docket No. TC-151070 requests forbearance from rate regulation pursuant to RCW 81.68.015. Certificate C-862 was issued by the Commission under RCW 81.68 to provide door-to-door auto transportation service between Thurston, Mason, Lewis, and Grays Harbor counties and the cruise terminals on the Seattle waterfront and Sea-Tac International Airport. Pacific also holds charter and excursion authority under certificate CH-58 issued by the commission in accordance with RCW 81.70. Pacific requests forbearance from rate regulation pursuant to RCW 81.68.015. Pacific asserts this service is for recreational purposes only and should be allowed forbearance from rate regulation (RCW 81.68.051).

Pacific proposes to provide door-to-door service between Pierce, Thurston, Mason, Lewis and Grays Harbor counties and:

1. Washington State Convention and Trade Center, Greater Tacoma Convention Center, CenturyLink Field, Safeco Field Tacoma Dome for Sporting Shows and Events, Boat Shows and Events, Home Shows and Events, RV Shows and Events, Golf Shows and Events; and
2. Sporting Events, Concerts, Casinos, Golf Courses, Wineries and Performing Arts Theaters in Washington.
