Dear Mr. King:

Our Company was notified by the Spokane Utilities Division that the tipping fee at the Waste to Energy Plant will increase from \$102.39 to \$105.36 per ton, a 2.9% increase, Notification attached. This will increase revenue for the residential customers by \$805 (.29%); commercial customers by \$310 (.28%); and drop box service by \$170 (2.9%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 1,080 residential, 90 commercial and 2 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase for Empire Disposal was approved by the Commission, September 1, 2013.

As instructed by the UTC staff during the audit of TG-132227 and TG-132228 the audited calculations have been updated with the increase in tipping fees, no changes to tonnage or customer counts have been made.

Attached are revised pages as well as supporting documentation to justify this increase. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective January 1, 2016. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2) (iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.

We also request that the Commission, on its own Motion under WAC 480-07-370 (b), allow this disposal fee filing as an exception to the general rate case workpaper rule at WAC 480-07-520.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to RCW 70.95.212 please accept this letter as 75 day notification of disposal rate adjustment.

New disposal rates becoming **effective January 1, 2016**, are as follows:

1. A 2.9% increase for solid waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy facility. Disposal fee at the Waste to Energy Plant is going from \$102.39 per ton to \$105.36 per ton.
2. The minimum fee is increasing from \$15.67 to \$16.12.
3. A 2.9% increase for clean green yard waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy facility. Disposal of clean green is going from \$48.36 per ton to \$49.76 per ton.
4. The minimum fee for clean green is increasing from \$5.15 to \$5.30.
