**(Set for June 21, 2016, at 9:30 a.m.)**

- 1 On April 18, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Penalty Assessment in Docket DG-160174 against Woodland Industries General Contracting Inc. (Woodland Industries or Company) in the amount of \$2,000, alleging two violations of RCW 19.122.030(1)(a) by failing to request a dig ticket prior to performing an excavation.
- 2 On April 28, 2016, Woodland Industries filed with the Commission a request for hearing on the form provided by the Commission. Woodland Industries checked the box on that form indicating that the Company admits to the violations, but requests a hearing to present evidence.
- 3 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the penalty should be mitigated and what actions are necessary for Woodland Industries to maintain future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of RCW 19.122.030.
- 4 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, June 21, 2016, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**
- 5 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

6 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.

7 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, **June 14, 2016**, and bring an original and one (1) copy to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and – 145.

8 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
