On April 29, 2016, Avista submitted to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) its 2015 Electric Commission Basis Report (CBR), pursuant to WAC 480-100-257. Recently it came to Avista's attention that its 12.2015 jurisdictional results of operations (ROO) reports had an incorrect tax amount recorded in its December 2015 results. These reports correct for this error.

Enclosed for filing is an electronic copy of Avista Utilities "Revised 2015 Electric Commission Basis Report." The original and two copies are being provided via overnight mail. (Due to the limited changes to certain workpaper pages, only hard copies of the "Revised" workpapers are being provided via overnight mail.) This report is being filed pursuant to WAC 480-100-257 and is based on the period of twelve months ended December 31, 2015. This report is being supplied for informational purposes only.

The information provided in the April 29, 2016 report regarding the additional CBR reporting requirements per UTC Commission Orders has not been revised¹.
