Staff's Request to Rescind Penalty Assessment TE-160717

Dear Mr. King:

On June 22, 2015, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a \$1,000 Penalty Assessment in Docket TE-160717 against Norhwest Smoking & Curing, Inc. for ten violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 480-30-071 and 480-30-076), which requires charter and excursion carrier companies to furnish annual reports to the commission no later than May 1 each year, except when May 1 is a weekend, in which case the annual report is due by the next business day. May 2 was the next business day.

This company has dual authority to operate as a charter & excursion carrier and to operate as an auto transporation company. This docket is a duplicate and was made in error. The violation of WAC 480-30-071 and 480-30-076 will be addressed in docket TC-160659. Staff recommends that the assessed penalty be withdrawn and the docket closed.
