Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 22, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Access Point, Inc. in the amount of \$175 for violations of WAC 480-120-382, which requires telecommunications companies to file their annual report and pay regulatory fees by May 1 each year. Access Point, Inc. filed its complete annual report on May 10, seven business days late. The Commission recognized that Access Point, Inc. does not have prior violations of WAC 480-120-382, and assessed a mitigated penalty. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated August 23, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$175 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$175 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$175 balance.
