RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TR-170562

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 6, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Washington & Idaho Railway Inc. in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of WAC 480-62-300, which requires railroad companies to file their annual report and pay regulatory fees by May 1 each year. Washington & Idaho Railway Inc. did not file its complete 2016 annual report or pay its 2017 regulatory fee by May 15, 2017, and has incurred a penalty of \$1,000. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated August 23, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$1,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$1,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
