## RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Janine Stockton-Julian

Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance TE-170646
Dear Mr. King:
On June 21, 2017, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a $\$ 1,000$ Penalty Assessment in Docket TE-170646 against Janine Stockton-Julian for ten violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 480-30-071 and 480-30-076), which requires charter and excursion carrier companies to furnish annual reports and the regulatory fee to the commission no later than May 1 each year. Janine Stockton-Julian had the option to have \$750 of the $\$ 1,000$ penalty suspended on the conditions that: (1) Janine Stockton-Julian files a complete annual report; and (2) pays any outstanding regulatory fee; and (3) pays the \$250 portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 15 days of the receipt of the Penalty Assessment Notice.

After reviewing commission records, staff confirmed on August 9, 2017, that all three conditions of the penalty suspension was met as Janine Stockton-Julian filed a complete annual report, paid the outstanding regulatory fee and paid the $\$ 250$ portion of the unsuspended penalty. As all three conditions have been met, it is staff's recommendation that the $\$ 750$ suspended portion of the penalty be waived and the docket closed.
