Dear Mr. King:

Enclosed please find revised pages for tariff number 9, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity credit adjustment.

For Pierce County Refuse the credit will decrease from \$.74 to \$.24 (-67.6%) per residential customer per month. This change affects approximately 50,700 customers in Pierce County.

For residential customers on Joint Base Lewis-McChord, also known as "EQR," the credit will decrease from \$.53 to \$.35 (-34%) per unit per month. This change affects approximately 4,900 customers on Joint Base Lewis-McChord.

Due to the volatility in the recycling commodity markets we are hereby requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351(2). The calculation uses the most recent six-month historical period to estimate the recycling commodity revenue/commodity credit for the next six months.

If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised commodity credit will go into effect on March 1, 2018. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(vi), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revised rates.
