The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has completed its review of the revised cost assessment questionnaire for the preliminary draft of the Asotin County Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan), submitted April 16, 2018.

The cost assessment questionnaire in the 2019-2024 Plan proposes no changes in tip fees at the transfer stations located in Asotin County. As a result, there will be no rate impact to ratepayers served by regulated solid waste collection companies in Asotin County at this time, as reflected in the table below.
