DECLARATION OF
BRIAN BRAUN

Brian Braun, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declares as follows:

1. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a Compliance Investigator in the Consumer Protection Section. As a Compliance Investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations regarding the business practices of regulated utility and transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate household goods carriers that may be operating without the required Commission permit.
2. On January 9, 2019, I found advertisements for Mover For You LLC online at moverforyou.com for a household goods moving company that supplied a truck. The advertisement also contained the telephone number (509) 818-5123, the owner's name, Mark Sacchetti, and rates for movers and a truck.¹
3. On January 9, 2019, I searched Commission records and found that Mover For You LLC was previously permitted. The Commission cancelled Mover For You LLC's temporary HHG permit (THG067933) on October 30, 2018, for failing to maintain insurance as required.²
4. Commission staff sent a cancellation letter sent to the company on October 30, 2018, which stated, "You must immediately CEASE all operations associated with this permit. If you advertise or operate as a household goods mover without a valid permit, the commission may take enforcement action against you."³
5. On January 9, 2019, I called (509) 818-5123 using an assumed name to obtain a quote for moving services including workers and a truck between two points within the state of Washington. The person answering the telephone identified the place of business as

Mover For You. The individual gave me an estimate of \$115 an hour for two workers and a truck. This was confirmed with an email message.⁴
