DECLARATION OF
BRIAN BRAUN

Brian Braun, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declares as follows:

1. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a compliance investigator in the Consumer Protection Section. As a compliance investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations regarding the business practices of regulated utility and transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate household goods carriers that may be operating without the required Commission permit.
2. On March 27, 2019, I found advertisements on www.visionarymovers.weebly.com for a household goods moving company that supplied a truck. The advertisement contained the business telephone number (206) 290-9261 and named Juston Leverette as CEO.¹
3. On March 27, 2019, I searched Commission records and found Visionary Movers LLC. The Commission cancelled Visionary's temporary household goods carrier permit (THG067560) on December 5, 2018, in Order 01 of Docket TV-180772 for failure to file an annual report and pay regulatory fees.²
4. On December 8, 2018, the Company signed the return receipt to acknowledge reception of the Order.³
5. The Order sent to the company stated, "The household goods carrier permits held by... Visionary Movers LLC are canceled for failure to file annual reports for 2017 and pay applicable regulatory fees."⁴
6. On March 27, 2019, I called (206) 290-9261 using an assumed name to obtain a quote for moving services including workers and a truck. A representative of the company who

identified himself as Juston gave me an estimate of \$115 an hour for two workers and a truck with a two hour minimum.
