RE: Rabanco Ltd. / Lynnwood Disposal Tariff Filing

Dear Mr. King:

Enclosed please find proposed Tariff No.4 of Rabanco Ltd, Certificate G-12, (dba Lynnwood Disposal), the purpose of which is a general rate increase request. It has been nearly two years since our last general increase on these rates and in that time we have experienced inflationary pressures on key operating costs and made investments in strategic operating assets. The proposed rates will also offset recent significant increases in recycling processing charges and organics composting tipping fees. If approved by the Commission, the overall revenue requirement increase reflected in this filing would approximate 11.24% or \$1,216,572.

The proposed rates impact services provided as follows:

Recycling:	+43.86%	\$742,345	43.86%
Yardwaste:	+27.06%	\$365,769	27.06%
Multi-Family Recycling:	59.41%	\$ 202,176	-1.28% to 40.2%
