DECLARATION OF BRIAN BRAUN

Brian Braun, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declares as follows:

- 1. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a compliance investigator in the Consumer Protection Section. As a compliance investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations regarding the business practices of regulated utility and transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate household goods carriers that may be operating without the required Commission permit.
- 2. On May 6, 2019, I found advertisements on www.thumbtack.com for a household goods moving company. The advertisement also contained a copy of a business card with a phone number of (206) 471-0986, a link to a Facebook page, and an introduction to the company's owner, "Sam."
- 3. On May 6, 2019, I searched the Washington State Department of Revenue's website for Brothers Moving. The results produced a contact name/governing individual of Samuel Owen Svarny with an address of 12431 2nd Pl SW, Seattle, WA 98146.²
- 4. On May 6, 2019, I searched Facebook and found an advertisement for Brothers Moving.³
- 5. On May 6, 2019, I searched Commission records and verified that Samuel Owen Svarny d/b/a Brothers Moving is not a permitted household goods carrier.
- 6. On May 8, 2019, a compliance letter was sent to Samuel Svarny notifying Brothers Moving to cease and desist operations as a household goods carrier in Washington state until he obtains the required household goods carrier permit from the Commission.⁴
- 7. On June 12, 2019, I called (206) 471-0986 using an assumed name to obtain a quote for moving services including workers and a truck. The starting point was Renton,

Washington, with delivery to Seattle, Washington. A company representative who identified himself as Sam gave me an estimate of between \$300 and \$500 for three to six hours with two workers and a truck. This was confirmed with a text message and an email.⁵
