Dear Mr. Johnson:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 3, for Waste Connections of Washington, Inc. G-253.

Our Company was notified that during the 2020 legislative session the state legislature increased the B&O tax from 1.5% to 1.75% effective April 1, 2020. With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a rate increase to pass this increase through to customers.

The increase is proposed as follows: Residential service \$31,500, .27%; commercial service \$17,300, .27%; and roll-off service \$3,500, .27%. There are approximately 68,000 residential; 4,200 commercial; and 300 roll-off customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by The Commission for Waste Connections of Washington became effective January 1, 2018.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages containing the increased rates, as well as supporting documentation for those changes. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they are intended to become effective on August 1, 2020.

Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
