
We were notified by Island County Public Works that the tipping fees at the Island County Coupeville Transfer Station are increasing, effective August 1, 2020. With this filing, we respectfully request to update the rates under G-154 to reflect the increase in disposal fee from \$109.00 to \$147.00 per compacted ton, a 34.86% increase; and from \$115.00 to \$155.00 per loose ton, a 34.78% increase. This will increase revenue from residential customers by approximately \$361,000 (12.65%); commercial customers by \$87,000 (8.28%); and drop box customers by \$197,000 (34.87%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 11,400 residential, 650 commercial, and 85 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase for G-154 became effective June 1, 2020.

Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective August 1, 2020. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2) (iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
