On October 21, 2020, Pacific Moving and Storage filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Household Goods Carriers carrier in the state of Washington.


On December 21, 2020, the Commission sent Pacific Moving and Storage notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Despite this notice, Pacific Moving and Storage has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter:

- Did not provide business license information.
- Did not establish ESD or L&I accounts.
- Did not provide a copy of driver's license for criminal background check.
- Did not provide a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) or proof of Cargo Insurance (Form H).

Accordingly, the application filed by Pacific Moving and Storage in TV-200878 for Household Goods Carriers authority is dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements.
