Northwest Paragliding Adventures LLC will provide regular passenger shuttle service for paragliders up and down Tiger Mountain from landing zone on Issaquah-Hobart Road to Poo Poo Point utilizing Issaquah-Hobart Road and a Department of Natural Resources managed private access forest road. Because of the scheduled nature of this route, the service qualifies as an auto transportation service. The company asserts that the service is not an essential transportation service, is solely for recreation and tourism, and would not adversely affect the operations of a regulated auto transportation company.
