Dear Valued Commercial and Multi-Family Customer,

July 21, 2021

This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for commercial services in the Lynnwood Disposal areas of Snohomish County. Should the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approve our request some customers will experience an overall rate increase throughout all classes of service.

As you may know, it has been more than a year since our last general rate case. In that time Lynnwood Disposal has experienced increases in costs that are key to delivering our services, including labor, fuel, and maintenance costs. **If approved, the proposed rates will become effective September 1, 2021.**

The proposed rate increases for our commercial, roll-off and multi-family services range from 1.3% to 14.2%. Most commercial and roll-off customers will experience an increase of 1.3% in rates and most multi-family customers will experience an increase of 6.35% to 14.22% tied to increases in recycling rates.

The Commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher than the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation.
