Dear Residential Customer,

This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for residential customers in the Rabanco Ltd. dba Tri-County Disposal, Allied Waste Services of Klickitat County, Rabanco Recycling, areas of Klickitat County. Should the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approve our request customers will experience adjustments to all services provided by Tri-County Disposal as outlined in the table below.

As you may know, it has been nearly two years since our last general rate case. In that time Tri-County Disposal has experienced increases in costs that are key to delivering our services including labor, fuel, and maintenance costs. In addition, the company continues to invest in new assets to ensure it can deliver the safest, most efficient service possible. **If approved, the proposed rates will become effective April 1, 2022.**

The proposed rate increase for our residential services is approximately 8.99% and not all residential services are listed above. Please also note that not all container sizes are available in all areas.

The commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher from the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is **scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on March 15, 2022.** You will have an opportunity to comment in person at this meeting.
