Do not re-docket. This is a part of UW-220859.

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

As previously communicated in its filing UW-220859, the Washington Water Service Company has acquired a non-regulated water system known as Driftwood Valley Camp WS (“DVA”).

Washington Water also respectfully requests a less-than-statutory notice waiver for this tariff change. The DVA homeowners association no longer desires to own and operate their water system. A special board meeting was held on September 25, 2021 where customers approved the sale of the system to Washington Water. The minutes of this meeting are attached as Exhibit 1.

Additionally, Washington Water requests to bring the DVA system under the rates currently in effect for its East Pierce service area tariff because of the benefits these new customers will receive. An analysis of the usage shows that if historical usage is maintained, the customers will pay a lower amount on an annual basis than they are paying today. This analysis is attached as Exhibit 2.
