NOTICE OF ERRATA TO ORDER 01

Re: *In the Matter of the Cancellation of the Commercial Ferry Certificate Held by Argosy, LP, for Failure to File an Annual Report and Pay Regulatory Fees,*
Docket TS-220869

TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 1, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 01, Cancelling Certificate (Order 01) in Docket TS-220869. It has come to the Commission's attention that paragraph 2 erroneously stated that the earlier Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate as a Commercial Ferry and Opportunity to Request a Hearing had been served on December 8, 2023. The correct service date was December 8, 2022. Paragraph 2 of Order 01 is hereby corrected to read as follows:

- 2 On December 8, 2022, the Commission served Argosy, LP, (Argosy or Company) with a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate as a Commercial Ferry and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) for failure to file the annual report and pay the regulatory fees that were due May 1, 2022.¹ The Notice informed Argosy that the Commission would cancel the Company's certificate without further notice unless the Company filed its delinquent annual report and paid its delinquent regulatory fee or requested a hearing to demonstrate why its certificate should not be cancelled within 30 days of the date the Notice was served.²

¹ Argosy holds authority to operate as a commercial ferry under certificate BC000101.

² Under WAC 480-07-150(4), the Commission may serve documents electronically except where proof of service is required by law. The Commission's Final Order adopting changes to WAC 480-07 accepted Staff's position that electronic service is acceptable for commencing adjudicative proceedings against regulated companies.
