A hearing was held on this application at Olympia, Washington on December 1, 1989, before Administrative Law Judge Elmer E. Canfield.

On January 19, 1990, the Administrative Law Judge entered the Initial Order in this matter, which was served on all parties of record.

Twenty days have passed since the entry of the order and no petition for administrative review has been filed by an affected party of record. Therefore, in accordance with RCW 34.05.464 and WAC 480-09-780(7) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure before the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the Initial Order is affirmed and its findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted by the Commission as its own for purposes of this proceeding.

## ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the Administrative Law Judge's order set forth in the Initial Order Authorizing Registration in Docket No. U-89-3123-AR is affirmed and that its findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted as the findings and conclusions of the Commission for purposes of this proceeding. In so doing,

## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That:

- 1. After the effective date of this order, the application of Intellicall Operator Services, Inc. filed with the Commission pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.36.350 requesting an order authorizing registration as a telecommunications company to provide service to the public in this state is approved.
- 2. Prior to providing service to the public as a telecommunications company, Intellicall Operator Services, Inc. shall file a tariff with the Commission identical to Exhibit G of the application. The tariff shall bear an effective date not less than one day subsequent to the date of receipt by the Commission.
- 3. Registration of Intellicall Operator Services, Inc. as a telecommunications company shall not be construed as an endorsement of financial viability, nor of the investment quality of any securities it may issue.
- 4. As a telecommunications company providing service to the public in this state, Intellicall Operator Services, Irc. is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission under the provisions of Title 80 RCW and all rules and regulations of the Commission adopted pursuant thereto, including WAC 480-120-141.
- 5. Intellicall Operator Services, Inc. shall file with the Commission on a quarterly basis, a complete and updated, confidential list of its Washington customers.

Jurisdiction is retained by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to effectuate the provisions of this order.
