The complaint alleges that PSE incorrectly installed a VASC Park Rectifier that caused the September 2, 2004, explosion at the house located at 16645 SE 26th Place, Bellevue, Washington. 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80.28.212, and WAC 480-93-010, WAC 480-93-015, -080, -110, -183, -186, 187, -188. Also applicable are RCW 34.05.479 and WAC 480-07-620, emergency adjudicative proceedings.
