DECLARATION OF KATHRYN MCPHERSON

KIM JONES D/B/A DESERT WAVE

Kathryn McPherson, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declares as follows:

- 1. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a Compliance Investigator in the Consumer Protection Section. As a Compliance Investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations regarding the business practices of regulated utility and transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate transportation companies that may be operating without the required Commission-issued certificate.
- 2. On November 9, 2018, the Commission received information that Kim Jones d/b/a Desert Wave (Desert Wave or Company) was engaging in unlicensed charter and excursion service.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. On January 15, 2019, I reviewed Commission records to determine if Desert Wave had authority to operate as a charter party and excursion service carrier in the state of Washington. I learned that on October 16, 2015, William Kim Jones, d/b/a Desert Wave, submitted an application for charter and excursion service authority. On the application, Mr. Jones listed a 2005 Hummer H2 with a seating capacity of 24 and a 2002 Monaco Socialite with a seating capacity of 28. Both vehicles are currently registered to Kim Jones d/b/a Desert Wave.
- 4. On March 31, 2016, the Commission granted charter certificate CH-067101 to Desert Wave. On June 8, 2018, Desert Wave requested via email to cancel its charter and

excursion certificate. On June 8, 2018, the Commission notified Desert Wave that its certificate CH-067101 was canceled. In its letter to the Company, the Commission directed Mr. Jones to cease all operations associated with the certificate.<sup>4</sup>

- 5. The Commission's records indicate that Desert Wave's business address is 2569 N. Columbia Center Blvd., Richland, WA 99352, and its telephone number is (509) 735-7359.
- 6. On January 15, 2019, I viewed online advertising by Desert Wave on its Squarespace site. The advertising depicted two stretch Hummers with stated seating capacities of up to 24 and 26 passengers, and a party bus with a seating capacity of up to 28 passengers.<sup>5</sup>
- 7. On January 16, 2019, using an assumed name, I called Desert Wave at (509) 735-7359. A person who identified himself as Kim with Desert Wave answered the phone. I requested a quote for transportation of 16 passengers from Columbia Point Golf Club in Richland, WA, to the Toyota Center in Kennewick, WA, for a 7 p.m. show on January 30, 2019. Kim provided a quote of \$115 for the trip and stated he could accommodate the group in one stretch Hummer.
