Re: TV-220723 - Rescinding Cancellation of Permit

Dear J & S:

On September 22, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) cancelled J & S, d/b/a MOCO, 's Household Goods Carriers permit THG069940, for failure to file proof of cargo insurance.

Proof of cargo insurance covering Household Goods Carriers permit THG069940 was filed with the Commission on September 22, 2022. The Commission records now reflect that proof of liability and property damage insurance covering permit THG069940 is properly filed.

The Commission, therefore, rescinds the cancellation and reissues permit THG069940 in the name of J & S. The permit is enclosed, and the company may again operate on a permanent basis.

J & S must continue to comply with state laws and Commission rules. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
