RE: Rabanco Ltd. / Eastside Disposal / Republic Services Tariff Revision (General Rate Case)

Dear Mr. Killip:

Enclosed please find proposed tariff No. 11 of Rabanco Ltd., Certificate G-12 (DBA Eastside Disposal), the purpose of which is a general rate increase request. It has been a year since our last general increase on these rates and in that time, we have experienced inflationary pressures on key operating costs and made investments in strategic operating assets. If approved by the Commission, the overall revenue requirement increase reflected in this filing would approximate 7.08% or \$534,269.

The proposed rates impact services provided as follows:

Garbage:	+9.58%	\$ 446,102	9% to 10%
Recycling:	-4.46%	-\$ 72,459	-5% to -4%
Yardwaste:	+9.95%	\$ 104,281	9% to 10%
Multi-Family Recycling:	+26.36%	\$ 56,145	11% to 25%

As required by Commission rules, a copy of this transmittal letter will be mailed to King County which is impacted by this filing. Customer notification letters will be mailed on or before March 15, 2024. The customer notices were previously reviewed by WUTC staff, and the final versions are included with this initial filing.
