The Commission's Fifteenth Supplemental Order in the above-referenced proceeding requires the filing of supplemental direct testimony on November 18, 2003. Pending before the Commission, however, is a motion to exclude Qwest rate issues from this proceeding. Verizon has filed a response to the motion proposing that the Commission defer further consideration of UNE rates for both Qwest and Verizon, and the Commission has established a November 10, 2003, deadline for responding to Verizon's proposal. In light of the potential impact of these issues on the need for, and content of, any supplemental direct testimony, AT&T, Covad, Commission Staff, Qwest, MCI, Verizon, and XO request that the Commission continue the November 18, 2003, filing date and schedule a prehearing conference, if necessary, to address scheduling issues after the Commission rules on the motion and Verizon's response.
