Dear Mr. Dorland:

I have reviewed the Engineering Report submitted by Western Engineers Inc. (received on May 30, 2001) concerning the engineering design for disinfection facilities at the Alder Lake water system. The following issues need to be addressed by your engineer before the project can be approved.

- 1. A dedicated inlet to reservoir is needed to maintain water-turn over and avoid stagnation in the existing 23,500 gallon tank.
- 2. Chlorine injection must be flow-proportional with one or both wells operating. Please revise the design to include two chemical feed pumps (each wired to a well pump circuit) or include a flow pulse meter to control the single feed pump.
- 3. Clarify the pipe material and joint specification for the 3-inch dedicated line (a number of material specifications are listed in the General Notes on sheet 1 of 2).
- 4. The dedicated line to storage must remain pressurized at all times. Please revise the design to include the appropriate back flow assembly to prevent gravity flow back to wells. Also include a means to monitor whether a pressure loss occurs (e.g. an appropriately graduated pressure gauge in the well house).

Regulations establishing a schedule of fees for review of planning, engineering and construction documents have been adopted (WAC 246-290-990). The fee covers our cost for the initial review plus the review of one response submittal. An invoice for \$301.00 is enclosed.
